

AUTOSLEW INSTALLING INFORMATION

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UPGRADE

In case you have an existing installation and want to upgrade to the latest Autoslew-Version you should run the upgrade. It will put AutoslewVB8.dll and ELServo.dll to the latest Version or add new dll's if needed. During Installation you may be asked if you want to repair or remove old version. Select repair then.

In case you are not asked but prompted to enter a folder where to install Autoslew make sure to install it in the right folder (some have different Autoslew-Versions on their PC). In doubt, check by mouse-right-click on your Desktop Autoslew Icon and check properties there you will see the location of your current Autoslew.

Current Version AutoslewVB8.dll is 5.0.0.3
Current Version ELServo.dll is 1.1.2.6

If you get a run time error after first start see trouble shooting below!

NEW INSTALLATION

In case you want to install Autoslew new on your computer you should run this. Be aware, that this will also delete your ini-Files. If you want to install completely new but save your old ini (Servoparameter, location, slewspeed etc.) settings make a copy of the following files:

E-Servos.ini
Autoslew.ini
Endpar.in

Save these files somewhere and put them in the new installed Autoslew folder after installation. Please remember it's **ALWAYS a good idea to make a complete copy of your Autoslew folder** if Autoslew is running properly because it has happened so many times that ini files were edited in a way that Autoslew could not start up any more. If you have a copy, you can simply throw above ini files back in the Autoslew folder and everything will work again.

TROUBLESHOOTING

After an upgrade it can happen that you get an error like "Automation error ..." or "Could not connect to ActiveX or Com component". In this case you will need to run (double click) the file RegisterAutoslewVB8DLL.bat that is located in your Autoslew folder.

If you have troubles with upgrading then you should consider a removal of your old software by Windows (Windows/Control Panel/ ...add/remove Programs) and then make a complete new installation AFTER SAVING YOUR INI FILES.
